**5 January 2018:** This evening Steve joined those who decided to venture out into the cold at the Talbot County Democratic HQ in Easton, MD for happy hour. Having been the coldest week in recent history, the drive under blizzard conditions with snow drifts quickly covering the newly cleared roads included winds that moved cars from their straight paths.

The article states that it was "watching Congress try to tackle health care reform earlier this year, and especially seeing so much of the Republican discussions happen behind closed doors and without input from Democrats, [that] drove him to consider running for office." Steve Worton was quoted as

saying, "I think the providers are charging a whole heck of a lot of money for things they don't need to be," and "pharmaceutical companies are also killing people with how much they charge for some of these medicines." Most importantly, the article captures one of Steve Worton's principle positions which is that "although Republicans are celebrating their recent success in tax reform, Worton believes voters should be more wary." He is then quoted as stating that "while they've said they promise to extend the middle class cuts beyond 2025, in hindsight, couldn't they have made the middle class cuts permanent and the corporate cuts temporary?"

The article sums up Steve Worton's position: "I think there are enough Democrats and Republicans who are tired of the way things have gone to such polar extremes that now is the time to bring it back together, one person at a time, and I don't think Andy Harris is doing the necessary things to make that change."
